1 month	Check up
2 months	Pediarix # 1, Hib # 1, Prevnar # 1, Rotarix #1
4 months	Pediarix #2, Hib #2, Prevnar #2, Rotarix #2
6 months	Pediarix #3, , Prevnar #3, ASQ
9 months	Check up
12 months	MMR # 1, Varivax #1, HEP A #1, HCT, Lead & TB screening, ASQ
15 months	DTaP #4, Hib #3, Prevnar #4
18 months	HEP A #2, Autism Screening, ASQ
2 year	Autism, Lead Screening, ASQ
2½ year	Check up, ASQ
3 year	Check up, Lead & Hearing Screening, ASQ
4 year	Lead, TB & Hearing screenings
5 year	DTaP #5, MMR #2, IPV #4, Varivax #2, Lead, TB & Hearing screenings, ASQ
6-18 Years	Yearly Check up
6th grade	Tdap, TB Screening, MCV#1
9th grade	TB Screening
Boys & Girls over 11yrs:	HPV, 3 dose series given 0-3 & 6 Months apart
12th grade	MCV#2

DTaP	Combines Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis
Hep A	Hepatitis A
Hep B	Hepatitis B
Hib	Haemophilus Influenza type B
HPV	Human Papillomavirus
IPV	Injectable Polio Vaccine
Menactra	Meningococcal
MMR	Measles, Mumps, Rubella
Pediarix	DTaP, IPV, Hep B
Prevnar	Pneumococcal
Rotarix	Rotavirus
Varivax	Chicken Pox
